OCEAN CITY UNIVERSITY

☀ Ocean City University was developed to provide public education and information on government services, public policy, organizational structure and operations. The curriculum covers all facets of municipal government.

☀ Students enrolled in Ocean City University have a better understanding of the government's role and relationship with its citizens and gives them a sense of ownership in government actions.

☀ Citizens and government work together to improve the quality of life for Ocean City residents. These informed citizens make a difference in the community.

COURSE OFFERINGS

Week 1 - Freshmen Orientation, History of Ocean City & Government Overview

Offers an introduction to municipal government. Students learn about the council-manager form of government, organizational structure of departments and intergovernmental relationships. Volunteerism on town boards is discussed.

Students ride the Boardwalk Train to the Life-Saving Station Museum for a guided tour.

Week 2 - Finance 101

Students learn about the budget and budget process, how their tax dollars work and gain an understanding of the financial operations of Ocean City.

Week 3 - Trains, Planes and Automobiles

Learn about the operation of the town's municipal bus system and how it relates to traffic in Ocean City. Course also covers the municipal airport and includes a tour of the facility.

Week 4 - Keeping the Records and Following the Law

Studies the inner workings and duties of the City Clerk's office. The City Solicitor also provides an overview of his position and role in government.

Week 5 - What Makes the City Run

Course looks at the town's purchasing processes, procedures and fleet management. Students learn about Information Technology and what's behind the scenes making everything work. Program includes a tour of the service center and warehouse.

Week 6 - Emergency Services

Studies in this program include a look at Communications, Emergency Management and Radio Communications. Participants also tour the communications center.

Week 7 - When you Call 911, 911 Calls Us

A look at our fire responders, fire protection services and emergency medical services from 3 divisions of the Fire Department.

Week 8 - REC 101 Studies in Recreation and Sports

Course provides an overview of recreation programs and services. Students learn about all recreation operations including Eagle's Landing Golf Course, Ocean City Tennis Center and Special Events Programs

Week 9 - Planning and Community Development 101

Course covers general duties and responsibilities of Planning and Community Development, including GIS and zoning overview.

Week 10 - Construction and Permits

Students learn about the permit process for building and construction. How the department works and the role of the building inspectors are just some of the topics covered.

Week 11 - Engineering and Environmental Services

Curriculum covers operations of the Engineering Department and duties of the City Engineer. Included is engineering's role in protecting the environment of the Maryland Coastal Bays.

Week 12 - Behind the Scenes - Public Works Operations

Course covers the operations of the Public Works Department from Administration to Maintenance and Construction.
